PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

•The highlighted words with strikethroughs are also Proposed Amendments, but shall be stricken upon a favorable vote.

•For approval, these Proposed Amendments require a two-thirds (2/3) vote of members present and voting.

ARTICLE V – OFFICERS, COMMITTEES, AND APPOINTED OFFICERS

Section A

1. The <u>Elected and Appointed Officers</u> shall be members of the Guild in good standing.

2. The <u>Elected</u> and <u>Appointed</u> <u>Officers</u> shall serve a term of one (1) year or until their successors are elected and assume office, and may serve one (1) consecutive term. After the consecutive term is completed, a minimum of one-year break must be taken before being eligible for this office again.

3. The <u>Appointed Officers</u> shall be appointed by the President with the approval of the Board by the beginning of the Fiscal Year, serve for a term of one (1) year, and are eligible for reappointment.

ARTICLE VII – NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS

Section E – The term of office for Elected Officers shall be that of the Guild's Fiscal Year, June 1 through May 31. The candidates elected shall serve a term of one (1) year or until their successors are elected and assume office. Those candidates elected may serve one (1) consecutive term, but after the consecutive term is completed, a minimum one-year break must be taken before being eligible for this office again.
