Basic Art Journaling Supply List

In the Workshop, we will create art journaling pages in several styles and formats. I encourage you to bring your favorite tools, in the colors that you prefer. The basics are listed below, with a few optional items that we can play with as well. Please don't buy anything specific for this workshop - Unless you just need an excuse to shop!

SUPPLY LIST:

- Watercolor paints (bring whatever you have)
- Watercolor Brushes -
 - *Round (size 6 or 8) my favorites change but usually include Princeton Heritage, Da Vinci or Beste Creative mark
 - * and a Flat if you have one, I like the Princeton Select (size 1")
- Micron pens/or similar waterproof markers (size 03 and 05)
- Pencil and eraser
- Kneaded eraser (**Important!)
- Artist tape
- Scissors and Xacto with small cutting mat
- Metal Ruler for cutting
- Containers (2) for water
- Colored pencils Regular or watercolor in your favorite colors
- Posca white marker or white gel pen
- Sumi Ink
- White gouache (if you have it)
- Glue stick (such as UHU) or double sided tape
- A few of your favorite things! Small objects, leaves, feathers, cups, keys, small pottery, vases, trinkets. (The "what" isn't important, as long as you love it)
- Calligraphy/lettering tools such as Brush pen, parallel pen, pointed pen/nib or broadedged pen/nib, Calligraphy marker chisel tip (whatever you like to write with)
- A favorite quote or group of words
- Paper / Sketchbook we will be creating our own small sketchbooks. I will be using Arches watercolor cold press paper 90 lb in a large sheet (22" x 30") because I think it's the most economical. However, I make lots of books using Canson XL Mixed Media Paper from the large, blue pad (18x24 or 14x17). Any paper that is at least 10x14 will work. We are NOT creating formal books, but rather assembling our individual pages into a "book". Bring what you like and are comfortable with.
- Extra paper: Drawing paper, sketch paper and/or watercolor paper (variety of your favorites)

Optional:

- Speedball handbook if you have one don't buy one!
- Charcoal pencil
- Neocolor II crayons or Gelatos if you have some
- Large acrylic marker (Posca or similar 15mm-not required. I'll bring a basic set)
- Folded calligraphy pen if you have one (any kind)
